Fruit of the Month: Peace

Key Passages: John 14:27; James 3:17-18; I Cor 3:1-22; Gal 3:26-29

Apr 12– Peace, from the inside out!

- Would you define our world as a peaceful place?
- If not, what are some of the things that contribute to a lack of peace?
- What are some different levels of peace (personal/with God, with other people, etc...)?
- Do you think that you having/not having peace in one of these levels will effect whether you find peace in the other levels?

Apr 19– 3 Not so hot guys. Read Daniel 3

- Do you think that Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego had an easy circumstance in the passage? What was the big decision(s) they had to make? What could make it difficult to find peace?
- How did these guys find peace in this story?
- It is hard to think of a situation that is as extreme as being thrown in a furnace, but what are some challenging situations you face?
- How can having a confident peace with God help in those times?

Mar 22– Disease that rots joy– dissensions

- What in the world are “dissensions”?
- How can unhealthy conflict kill peace?
- If you really struggle with unhealthy conflict (whether it is with yourself, with God, or with other people) what are some ways to decrease that friction or turn it into something positive?
