

EVALUATING & MANAGING YOUR MINISTRY

The goal of shepherding is to encourage people both in their personal growth as well as their ministry. The focus is on both what God is doing *in* someone and what God is doing *through* someone.

Prayerfully consider the specific individuals in your group and ask yourself the following two questions:

1. How can I encourage the work God is doing IN them individually?
2. How can I encourage the work God is doing THROUGH them individually to minister to others?

You can ask the same two questions of your group in general:

1. How can I encourage the work God is doing IN our group?
2. How can I encourage the work God is doing THROUGH our group to minister to others?
